


Sniffing Out Your Dog's Nose








Dogs smell up to 100,000 times better than we do!

Scatter Feeding





Sniffy Walks

Let your dog set the pace and the route you take. Let them smell ALL the smells. Don't rush them or pull them from an interesting smell.

A 15 minute sniffy walk will tire them more than an hour jog

Lay a Scent Trail

Drop kibble along a path with twists and turns that lead to a very special treat, maybe steak bites, pancakes, or chicken! Watch your dog follow the trail to the bonus at the end!

Muffin Man

What you need





Enough balls to fill the holes

- 1 Place a smelly bit (tripe, hot dog, cheese) or their kibble in each void
- 2 Place the balls on top of the food. Have the dog sniff out the food. They will need to remove the ball to get the reward.
- 3 Struggling? Place food around the balls to jump-start the game. Still struggling? Lift a ball or two for them.
- 4 Level Up? Place food under only a few of the balls. Did they only go for the ones with food?
